

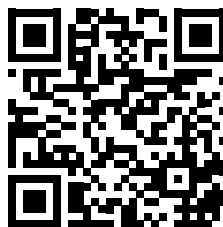
## WHAT ARE 'WARNING DAYS'?

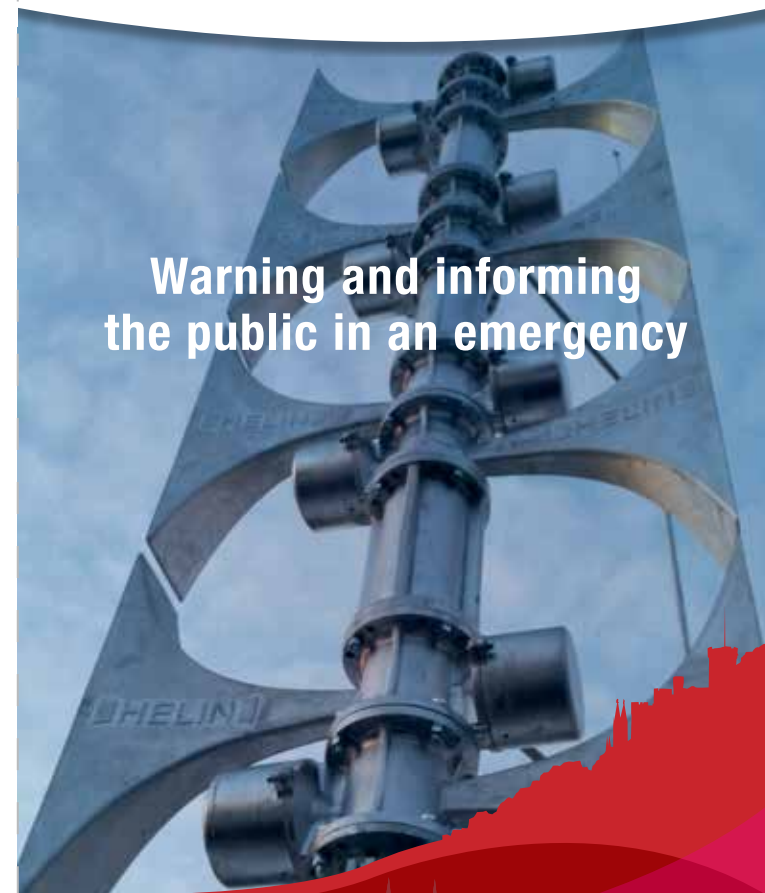

## WHAT SIREN SIGNALS ARE THERE?

### WARNING!



**High-low siren  
lasting for 1 minute**



**An incident has  
occurred nearby**



**Keep calm and  
follow the instructions**

### All-clear



**Continuous tone  
lasting for 1 minute**



**The danger has passed**



**You no longer need to  
follow the instructions  
given earlier.**

## WHAT SHOULD I DO?

### WHAT TO DO

- Keep calm
- Listen to loudspeaker announcements
- Go to your apartment or another building
- Close the doors and windows
- Help children and vulnerable people and give shelter to any passers-by who need help
- Use the sources of information listed here (see reverse)
- Inform the neighbours in your apartment building
- Leave your children at school or nursery – they are safe there
- Switch off the air-conditioning or ventilation
- Only dial 112 if you need emergency assistance yourself

## WHEN WILL A WARNING SOUND?

Serious incidents pose a threat to your safety and your property. Warning and informing the public is an important part of fire and disaster protection. As a member of the public, you can help to keep yourself safe and protect your relatives and neighbours by following these instructions.

### WE WILL WARN YOU OF INCIDENTS SUCH AS:

- Major fires
- Storms
- Flooding
- Bomb disposal
- Leaks of harmful substances
- Other acute hazards

if they affect a significant number of people in your area.
